

## Hunterdon Medical Center Laboratory Lactose Tolerance Instructions

## **Collection Instructions:**

It is imperative all collection tubes are properly labeled with the patient's last name, first name, date of birth, date and time of collection.

- 1. Perform finger stick glucose prior to administering Lactose®. *NOTE:* If glucose is 160 mg/dl or greater contact the ordering Physician for instructions.
- 2. Draw *fasting* venipuncture specimen prior to administering the Lactose® solution; label this specimen tube *fasting* with the date and time of collection.
- 3. Give Lactose® according to the following:
  - Infants/children up to 12 years: 2g/kg of body weight with a maximum of 50g in 250ml water
  - Adults: over 12 years: 50g in 250ml of water.
- 4. Begin the timing of your first specimen to be collected after the patient has *finished* the Lactose® solution.
- 5. The remaining specimens are to be collected at 30 minutes, 1 hour, 2 hour, and 3 hour intervals.
  - label each tube with the appropriate times of each collection listed above
