Approximate Detection Times

* **Note:** These are approximate detection times for the drug or metabolites in urine. The actual detection time depends on dose, frequency of use, and individual metabolism.

Codeine	3 days
Dihydrocodeine	3 days
Hydrocodone	3 days
Norhydrocodone	3 days
Hydromorphone	3 days
Oxycodone	3 days
Noroxycodone	3 days
Oxymorphone	3 days
Noroxymorphone	3 days
Naloxone	3 days
Morphine	3 days
